ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the Association is INCORPORATED TRUSTEES OF KEEN HEART FOUNDATION

ARTICLE 2: ADDRESS

The address of the Association shall be :
 PLOT 2967, JUSTICE CLARA OGUNBIYI CRESCENT, ASOKORO, (ABUJA, FCT)

ARTICLE 3: AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The aims and objectives of the association are:

1. To engage in humanitarian and charity objective both at National and International level by assisting the less privilege and also to empower the poor in the society through skill acquisition, job creation opportunities, and poverty alleviation. .
2. To distribute victuals to the needy and less privileged and to also empower and develop the less privileged people in the society, cater for the old people, destitute and to liaise with Government Agencies in fulfilling charity organization objectives in the society.
3. To provide scholarship, feeding and clothing to the less privileged children and indigent students in the society and also to help, nurture and demonstrate and assist the abandon babies' orphanages, prisoners, sick people and less privilege.
4. To assist widows in building their capacity to make them economically independent, to empower the widow through skill acquisition programmes, to assist the old age people, and also to cater for the welfare of prisoners, people that are ~~incapacitated, dependent, ill, women patients in the hospitals and any person that is~~ incaptivity or rejected, abused & oppressed persons in the society.
5. To provide education for educationally challenged teenagers, widow and young adults, to enlighten teenagers and young adults on fundamental human and their right in the society and also to enlighten teenagers and young adults on the benefits of descent and appropriate dressing.
6. To increase self-sustainability of target poor

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- A. The Trustees of KEEN HEART FOUNDATION for the purpose of the Companies and Allied Matters Act CAP C20 LFN 2004, shall be elected at a General Meeting charged with responsibility of selecting the Trustees with 2/3 majority votes of members present.
- B. Such Trustees (Hereinafter referred to as, "The Trustees") shall not be less than 2 and more than 10 in number.
- C. A Trustee may hold office for 5 years but shall cease to hold office if he:
- Resigns his office
 - Ceases to be a member of the registered Trustees of the body.
 - Becomes insane
 - Is officially declared bankrupt
 - Is convicted of a criminal offence involving dishonesty by a Court of competent jurisdiction
 - Is recommended for removal from office by a board of Governors and Trustees majority vote of members present at any General Meeting of the body
 - Ceases to reside in Nigeria
- D. Upon a vacancy occurring in the number of Trustees a General Meeting will be held to appoint another eligible member of the Association.

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- A. The Trustees shall have a Common seal.
- B. Such seal will be kept in the custody of the SECRETARY who shall produce it when required for use by the Trustees.

ARTICLE 7: GOVERNING BODY

Governing body shall be appointed to any salary office of the FOUNDATION paid for by fees, and that no remuneration or other benefits in money or monies shall be given by the FOUNDATION to any member of such Council or Governing Body except repayment of out-of pocket expenses or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised or let to the FOUNDATION provided that the provision last aforesaid shall not apply to any payment of any company to a member of the FOUNDATION may be a company in which such member shall not hold more than one-hundredth part of the capital and such member shall not be bound to account for any share of profits he may receive in respect of any such payment.

ARTICLE 8: SOURCES OF INCOME

The sources of income for the Association shall include:

- 1 Accept donations (in cash and/or kind) from individuals, corporate bodies, relevant organizations in Nigeria or elsewhere.
- 2 Receive grants or assistance from countries, individuals, Trusts, Initiative and other charitable or philanthropic organizations in Nigeria and outside Nigeria
- 3 Accept donations and levies from the members.
- 4 Collect monies and financial assistance from members of the public through any lawful means.

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Financial year of the Keen Heart Foundation shall be from 1st January to 31st December of every year. All expenditure (Current Capital or otherwise) of the Foundation must be duly countersigned by Treasurer of the FOUNDATION. And there shall be one current account for the Keen Heart Foundation.

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The Keen Heart Foundation shall operate bank accounts in its name. The signatories to the account shall be the CHAIRMAN, and the SECRETARY. All monies must be paid into the account immediately upon receipt and no account shall the SECRETARY keep a cash of more than N50,000.00 with him/her at any point in time Foundation shall ensure the accurate keeping of record of all income and expenditure. ARTICLE 11: APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR(S)

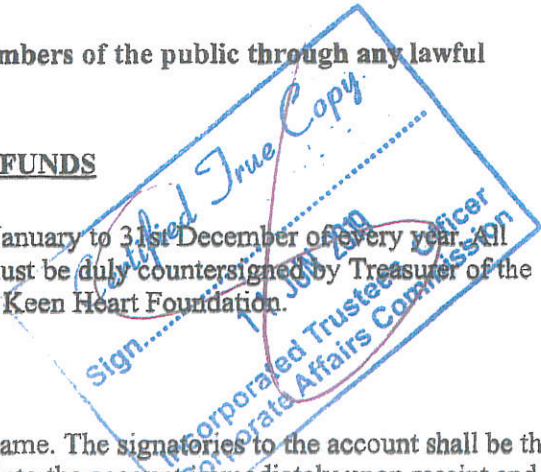

ARTICLE 12: AMENDMENT OF CONSTITUTION

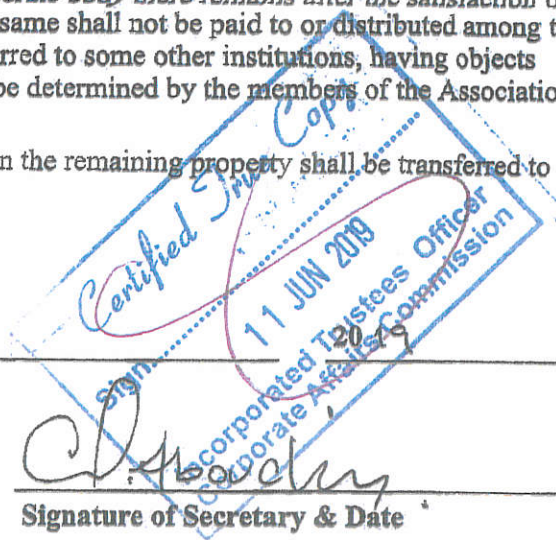
The Association may alter the provision of its Constitution at a General meeting by a resolution passed by a simple majority of its members and approved by the Commission.

ARTICLE 13: SPECIAL CLAUSE

- 1. THE INCOME AND PROPERTY OF KEEN HEART FOUNDATION shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objective of the body as set forth in this RULES AND REGULATION/CONSTITUTION: and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit, to the members of the Association.
- 2. PROVIDED that nothing herein shall prevent the payment in good faith, or reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or servant of the Association in return for any service actually rendered to the Association:
 - a. With the exception of ex-officio members of the Governing Council, no member of the Council of Management or Governing Body shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Association or any office of the Association paid by fees; and



- b. No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the body to any member of such Council or Governing Body except repayment of out of pocket expenses or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised, or let to the Association or reasonable fees for services rendered.
- 3. If in the event of a winding up or dissolution of the corporate body there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Association but shall be given or transferred to some other institutions, having objects similar to the object of Association, such institutions to be determined by the members of the Association at or before the time of dissolution.
- 4. If effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provisions, then the remaining property shall be transferred to some charitable object.
